

Please bring to your DPM doctor

Due to strict Medicare guidelines on documentation requirements, in order to provide diabetic shoes to our mutual patient the patient must obtain the following information from their DPM.

- 1. Prescription for your diabetic shoes
- Most recent foot exam notes must be within 3 months of your appointment with Lawall.
 Within the notes there must be at least 1 of the following:
 - Complete amputation of foot or toes
 - History of foot ulceration of either foot
 - History of pre-ulcerative calluses of either foot
 - Peripheral neuropathy with evidence of callus formation of either foot.
 - Foot deformity of either foot
 - Poor circulation in either foot must be established through testing such as pedal pulses. The presence of edema alone is not sufficient.
- Must be signed and dated by the DPM
