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**Please bring to your DPM doctor**

**Due to strict Medicare guidelines on documentation requirements, in order to provide diabetic shoes to our mutual patient the patient must obtain the following information from their DPM.**

1. Prescription for your diabetic shoes
2. Most recent foot exam notes must be within 3 months of your appointment with Lawall.

Within the notes there must be at least 1 of the following:

- ❖ Complete amputation of foot or toes
  - ❖ History of foot ulceration of either foot
  - ❖ History of pre-ulcerative calluses of either foot
  - ❖ Peripheral neuropathy with evidence of callus formation of either foot.
  - ❖ Foot deformity of either foot
  - ❖ Poor circulation in either foot – must be established through testing such as pedal pulses. The presence of edema alone is not sufficient.
- ❖ Must be signed and dated by the DPM
